Cardiff ranks highly in undergraduate opinion

Cardiff University is ranked fifth in a survey of undergraduates' perceptions of universities

In a survey of 10,000 graduates, students were asked to reflect on their experiences during the application process and how they generally perceived their university.

Cardiff was also ranked seventh as the perceived most exciting city and high quality campus in the 44-question 'Opinionpanel' survey.

Some 80 per cent of responses said that 'a friendly campus feel' was important in their choice of institution and 72 per cent felt that attending a university that they perceived to 'be strong in league tables was a major influencer. Other factors instrumental in students choices were academic reputation, quality of course and teaching, recommendations by parents or teachers, good transport links, helpful staff and an impressive Open Day.
